She did nothing but (cry, to cry, crying) all day.

He intended to have done it. [重文に] He intended to do it, but he didn't [couldn't] (do so).

I expected her to have helped me. [従属節のある文に]

I expected that she would help me, but she didn't do so.

- { It is natural that he should get angry.
- { It is no (wonder) that he get angry.
- { He has good (reason) to get angry.
- { He (may) well get angry.

(To) do my best, I could not understand it.

(Needless) to say, perseverance is necessary for success.
